

Himley Lake – Wabeno (Forest County)

The lake is 121 acres in size, with six miles of shoreline; the aerial map show lots of irregular shoreline to explore with a few tiny islands. There are no dwellings on the lake. There is lots of room to park vehicles at the boat landing; the access to the water is a sandy beach. On both sides of the landing are primitive campsites. Himley Lake Road on the west of the lake nears the shoreline in two places, but they are not suitable as launching points.



Boat Landing from hwy 32 (blue on map, allow 35 minutes drive time from downtown Lakewood):

- On hwy 32, north of Wabeno, turn left on hwy 52; drive 2.6 miles.
- Go straight on cty W (when 52 turns left); drive 1.8 miles.
- Turn right onto Richardson Lake Road (FR 2880); drive about 0.1 mile.
- Turn left onto Birch Lane; drive about 0.6 miles to the boat landing.

Everyone should wear a PFD (personal flotation device).
