

Silver Lake – Laona (Forest County)

The lake is 316 acres in size; it has northern pike, small-mouth bass, and panfish. Check out the Lumberjack Steam train to the museum complex and pontoon tours.

Public Boat Landing (red on map):

- Turn left (west) on 32/8 at the stop sign where 32 and 8 meet as you enter Laona.
- Drive 1.8 miles (past golf course & Cheney Supper Club & west end of Silver Lake) to West Silver Lake Road.
- Turn (left) here; drive for 0.4 mile to where the other end of the Silver Lake Loop Road comes in, just over a rise in the road. As you approach that point, there is a "Dead End" sign on the right. Look to the left and you will see the lake and the boat landing.
- Turn left and drive down to the boat landing.

Everyone should wear a PFD (personal flotation device).
