

Rose Lake – Langlade (Langlade County)

This is a beautiful lake with very little development; it has an irregular-shaped shoreline which is interesting to explore.

Route to boat landing (red on map):

- Turn west from hwy 32 onto highway 64; drive 5.2 miles. Go straight through intersection with county T; drive another 6.3 miles (total of 11.5 miles).
- Turn right on highway 55; drive 4.3 miles.
- Turn right on FR2122 (Sawyer Lake Road); drive 3.2 miles.
- Turn right on Rose Lake Road (FR2336); drive 0.6 miles (all roads to this point are paved).
- Turn right onto Rose Lake Drive (gravel road – hard packed surface); drive 1.4 miles to the lake. Spacious parking lot.

Everyone should wear a PFD (personal flotation device).

The National Forest requires a parking permit. A daily permit may be purchased at the site; an annual permit for \$10 is available at the Ranger Station in Lakewood, or at the Parkside Quik-Mart in Mountain.
