

Sawyer Lake – Langlade (in Langlade County)

This is a beautiful lake with homes around it. The main boat landing is a town park (has outhouse); it is barely outside the National Forest. The lake is 169 acres in size. Silver Birch Ranch is situated on the east shore of the lake.

Route to Boat Landing (red on map):

- Turn west from hwy 32 onto highway 64; drive 5.2 miles. Go straight through intersection with county T; drive another 6.3 miles (total of 11.5 miles).
- Turn right on highway 55; drive 4.3 miles.
- Turn right on FR2122 (Sawyer Lake Road); drive 0.5 miles.
- Turn left at Boat Landing sign. Road is blacktop with spacious parking lot.

2nd Boat Landing (hot pink on map):

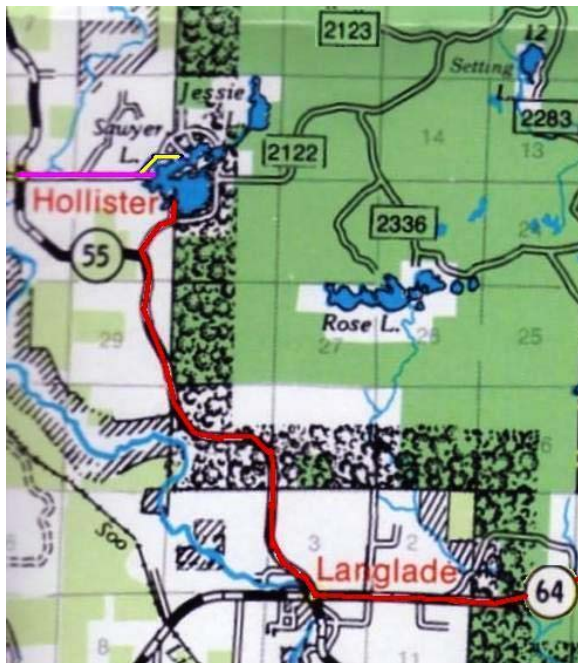
- Turn east on Hollister Road; go about 1½ mile straight to lake.

3rd Boat Landing (yellow on map):

- From Hollister Road, veer to left less than half mile to unimproved boat landing.

Everyone should wear a PFD (personal flotation device).

The lake has many interesting features to explore; it is divided by a long, thin peninsula. Toward the southwest end of the peninsula is a narrow, shallow passage to the rest of Sawyer Lake. You may have to walk your canoe/kayak through this passage in low water conditions. At the northeast end of the lake, a channel leads into Jessie Lake, which is mostly undeveloped as it is in the Nicolet National Forest.
