

## **Caldron Falls Flowage on the Peshtigo River Boat Landing #11 – Crandall Creek**

This is now part of the Peshtigo River Forest, formerly Wis. Public Service land.

*(Note that the Boat Landings were numbered in sequence when they were built, and are not in sequence along the road.)*

We will meet at Boat Landing #11, which is accessed via Boat Landing #11 Road, and is on the west of Parkway Road.

- From the north it is approximately 2 miles south of county C.
- From the southwest you could take Caldron Falls Road to Boat Landing #11 Road.
- From the east you could follow county X west until it meets Parkway Road and then drive north. Turn left on Ranch Road, then north on Caldron Falls Road.

When we get on the river, we can turn left and paddle upstream as far as Boat Landing #12 (Roaring Rapids), which is on the east side of the river.

We can turn right on the river and paddle downstream. After we pass Boat Landing #10, the river is wider, and is called the Caldron Falls Flowage.

After we paddle, we can stop somewhere for supper.

I offer two maps, as they each give different details. On page 2, the brown areas denote the Gov. Thompson State Park. The green areas denote Wis. Public Service lands.

The map on page 3 is from an old Wis. Public Service map of the Peshtigo Flowages; the green areas denote all the former Wis. Public Service lands. Boat Landings are designated by red dots.

You can choose to make this a one-way paddle (downstream) by starting at Boat Landing #12, and parking at least one vehicle beforehand at another Boat Landing downstream.
