

Horn Lake – Explosion Lake - Reservoir Pond & Little Horn Lake near Townsend (Oconto County)

Horn Lake is 123 acres in size; Explosion Lake is 29 acres; Little Horn Lake is 20 acres and Reservoir Pond is 289 acres in size. Residents have told us you can pass from one lake to another with a pontoon boat, and can even access this area from Townsend Flowage via McCaslin Brook. So we can surely enjoy paddling the area in our canoes or kayaks! Everyone should wear a PFD (personal flotation device).

Water Street Boat Landing by Little Horn Lake (green on map):

- Turn left from hwy 32 onto cty T; drive 2.5 miles.
- Turn right onto Burndt Dam Road; immediately veer left; travel 0.3 miles.
- Turn right on Valley View Road (no stop for right turn); travel 0.1 mile.
- Turn left onto Water Street; 0.1 miles to boat landing. Ample parking.

Forest Ave. Boat Landing on Reservoir Pond (yellow on map):

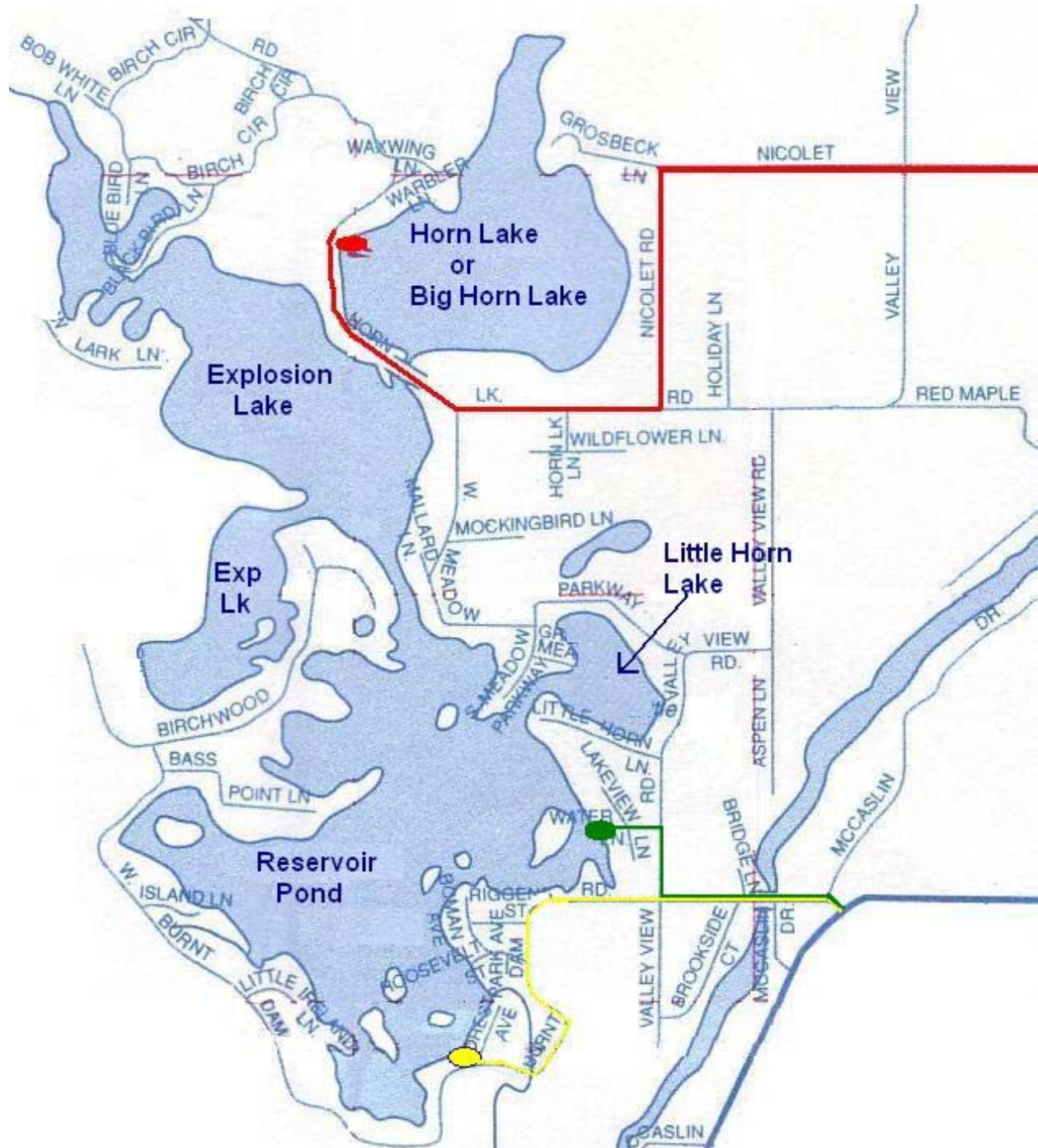
- Turn left from hwy 32 onto cty T; drive 2.5 miles.
- Turn right onto Burndt Dam Road; immediately veer left; travel 1.13 miles.
- Turn right at Forest Avenue; the boat landing is right at intersection. Ample parking.

Horn Boat Landing on Horn Lake (red on map):

- Turn left from hwy 32 onto Nicolet Road (at Mike's Super Valu).
- Drive 1.4 miles; turn left on Valley View Road.
- Drive 0.4 miles; turn right onto Horn Lake Road.
- The boat landing is 1.2 miles ahead on the right; well marked, but parking is a problem.
