

Townsend Flowage – Townsend (Oconto County)

We can paddle between the two portions of the flowage, passing under the bridge near Hillcrest Lodge. On the west shore of the south flowage there is an island with a memorial containing names of the KIA from Iraq & Afghanistan. The flowage is 380 acres in size; it has northern pike, walleye, large-mouth bass, small-mouth bass, and panfish. We usually start at the South boat landing.

South Boat Landing (red on map):

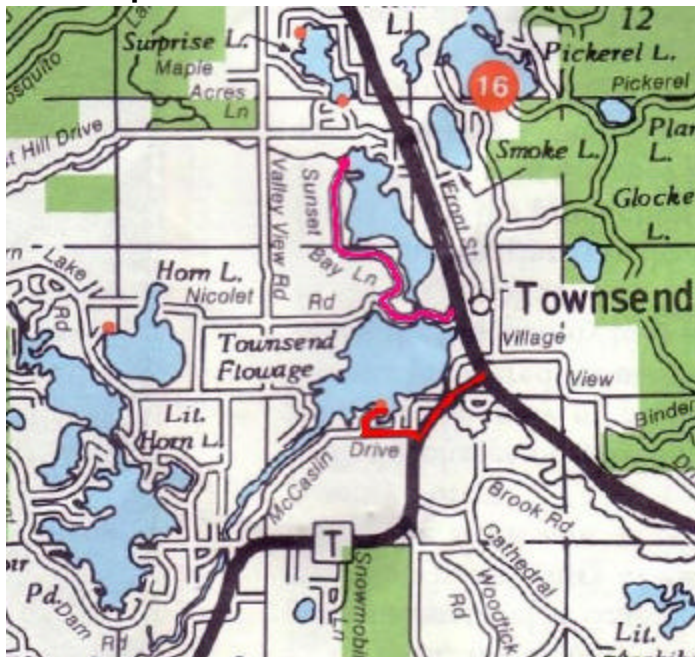
- Turn left from hwy 32 onto county T; drive 0.6 miles.
- Turn right onto McCaslin Drive; drive 0.3 miles.
- Turn right onto Bennett Lane.
- At the “T” turn right to unimproved boat landing.

North Boat Landing (hot pink on map):

- Turn left from hwy 32 onto Nicolet Road (at Mike’s Super Valu); drive 0.4 miles.
- Turn right onto Sunset Bay Lane (at Hillcrest Lodge).
- Continue 1.3 miles to end of the road to unimproved boat landing.
- This area is weedy until you get out into the flowage.

Everyone should wear a PFD (personal flotation device).
