

Wheeler Lake – Lakewood (Oconto County)

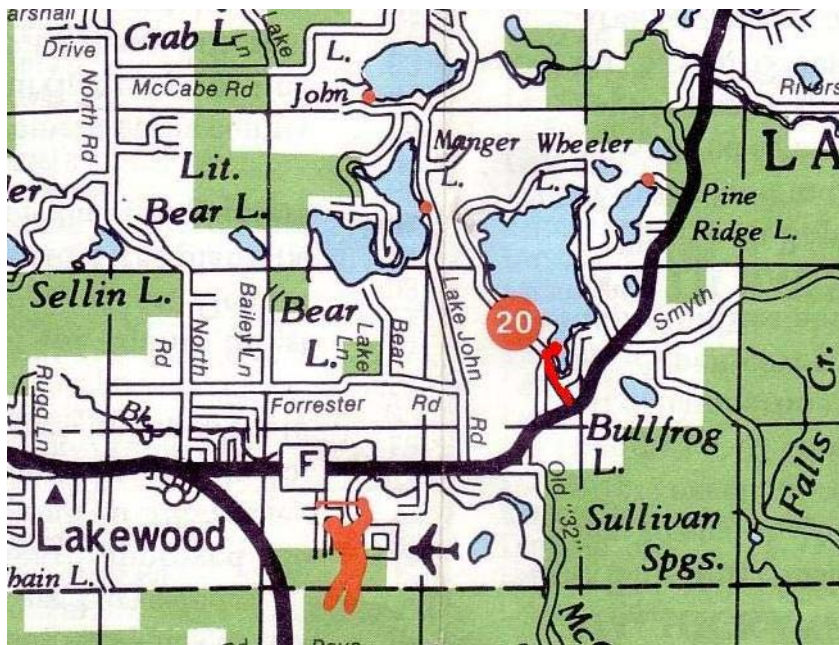
This lake is very pretty, and is heavily populated. The shoreline is heavily wooded, so that the homes are barely visible. There are two islands around which we can navigate. You can see a loon, green heron, and possibly a muskrat. The lake is 293 acres in size with a maximum depth of 35 feet. Much of the area near shore is shallow; watch for rocks in northern part of the lake, especially near the islands. The lake has northern pike, walleye, bass, and panfish.

Boat Landing (red on map):

- Drive east of Lakewood on county F.
- Turn left on West Wheeler Lake Road.
- Turn right at the boat landing sign; drive down a hill. There is ample area to unload boats. Drive back up the hill to park on the road.
- Red#20 on map is Wheeler Lake Picnic Ground; it has a swimming beach, picnic tables, drinking water, and vault toilets

Everyone should wear a PFD (personal flotation device).
